


I am good at working with others.

I am good at communicating with others.


I can communicate well.

I can manage money well.


I have money management skills.

I have teaching skills.




I am good at organizing.

I am good at multitasking.


I can multitask.

I am good at loading and unloading goods.


I can load and unload goods well.

You can change verbs to nouns by adding "ing". We call this "gerund" "Gerund" can be used as a subject in sentences. It usually talks about activities.

e.g. "Sleeping is good for me." "Swimming is fun." ("Sleeping" & "Swimming" are the subjects in the sentences)
